1. Go to [www.macoupinvotes.com](http://www.macoupinvotes.com)



2. Hit 'Election Results' near the top of the screen.



3. Hit any election starting with the 2012 General Primary from either the dropdown or 'Election Archives'.



4. If you use the 'Election Archives', then in the 'Choose Year' box, pick the year of the results, starting in 2012, you are looking for.



5. Then hit the red box of the election you are looking for.



## HOW TO SEE WHICH PRECINCTS HAVE REPORTED ON ELECTION NIGHT

1. There are two ways. First, on nearly every page, near the top on the right hand corner is a count of 'Partially Reported' and 'Completely Reported' precincts that updates as the night goes on.


